characteristics

verb- separate into parts to study relation-ships

analyze

The teacher analyzed the benchmark results.

to synthesize

example

definition

to put into action; to be appropriate for use

characteristics

verb- putting something into use or requesting something

apply

He will apply to college next year.

example

not putting into action or use

Word of the Week 09/23/13

definition

an oral disagreement;a statement, reason, or fact for or against a point

characteristics

noun- discussing with oppo-site points of view

argument

Mom and dad had an argument about whether or not I deserve a new phone.

Everyone pleasantly agreed to buy me a new phone.

example

Word of the Week 09/30/13

definition

the group of spectators at a public event; listeners or viewers

characteristics

noun- the people reached by a book; followers of a public entertainer

audience

I wrote my essay for a teenage audience.

example

This essay is per-sonal and no-body will ever read it.

characteristics

verb- describe by labeling, sort things out, color -code items

categorize

characteristics

verb- associate things, find relationships, identify with, match

compare

characteristics

verbbuild, create, make

construct

When trying to answer a trivia question, people construct a range of possible values based on their knowledge.

to destroy, bring apart

example

characteristics

verb- differentiate, discriminate, distinguish, oppose

contrast

Compare and contrast causes for extinction, past and present

Looking for similarities

definition

to tell or depict in written or spoken words; give an account of

characteristics

verb- portray, characterize, represent; recount, tell, relate

describe

They will look at pictures of these animals and describe the similarities and differences in their appearances.

example

To narrate events in time.

to elaborate verb-build, or expand in detail

characteristics

form, elaborate

develop

The ethmoidal cells begin to develop during fetal life.

verb- separate out two or more things, look at and understand what makes two things different

differentiate

characteristics

verb- show the difference in things

distinguish

being able to identify the difference between oranges and tangerines

evaluate

The teacher reviews a paper to give it a grade. Taking any kind of medication when you are sick.

example

to make clear the cause or reason of; account for

characteristics

verb- making the meaning of some-thing clear or understandable

explain

I cannot explain his strange behavior.

providing no reasons for a particular behavior

example

definition

to set forth the opinions, feelings, etc., of (oneself), as in speaking, writing, or painting

characteristics

verb- to declare, indicate, signify something

express

He can express himself eloquently.

example

He conceals his feelings well.

to bing into existence; cause to be; produce

characteristics

verb- coming up with something new, to create or make

generate

The office staff generated a list of students eligible for the pizza party.

example

not making anything or destroying

Word of the Week 01/20/14

definition

to recognize, to make, represent to be, or regard

characteristics

verb- distinguish, place, know, determine.

identify

As students look at the map, have them identify the city and some of its suburbs.

All cities can be found in all states.

example

definition

suggested without being directly or explicitly stated; tacitly understood

characteristics

adjective- to assume, include, signify something

implied

Order is implied in the existence of mathematical truths

example

Explicitlystated

definition

to conclude or judge based on evidence and good reasoning

characteristics

verb- put clues together, analyze what is not explicitly said or written

infer

The detective found a fingerprint in the suspect's room, so the detective infers the suspect is guilty.

example

Giving an opinion based answer with no evidence to support it

definition

the action or process of producing effects on the actions, behavior, opinions, etc., of another or others

characteristics

verb/noun- incite, rouse, arouse, instigate, induce, persuade.

influence

Her mother's influence made her stay.

Not letting anybody's words determine your actions.

example

definition

to bring out the meaning of (a dra-matic work, music, etc.) by performance or execution.

characteristics

verb- to clarify or explain something

interpret

How you define words will impact how you interpret combinations of words.

example

I cannot get the meaning of this.

the way that similar or related texts influence, reflect, or differ from each other:

characteristics

adjective- relationship between and across texts

intertextual

The intertextuality between two novels with the same setting.

example

not making connections across different texts

characteristics

verb- giving an acceptable reason or explanation, providing evidence and support for a decision

justify

The student justified each budgetary expense as necessary in her Math homework.

example

criticizing, retracting or taking back what you said

to systematize characteristics

verb-to form a whole from interdependent parts

organize

I organized the files from my teacher's cabinet.

example

The filing cabinet contains papers that are all mixed up.

definition

convincing, compelling, forceful

characteristics

adjective-able, fitted, or in-tended to convince

persuasive

Her argument was so persuasive the judge ruled in her favor.

example

Opinions are not persuasive if they are not supported by facts.

definition

to declare or tell in advance

characteristics

verb- to know or tell (usually correctly) beforehand what will happen

predict

Satellite data is the only way to predict storms

I already know we will have a test this Friday because the teacher told us.

example

comparative relation between things or magnitudes as to size, quantity, number,

characteristics

nouncomparison, share, distribution, arrangement

proportion

The amount of power generated increased in proportion to the number of drop-lets used.

example

The absolute amount of something compared to nothing but itself.

definition

The relation between two quantities expressed as the quotient of one divided by the other

characteristics

noun- percentage, correlation, rate

ratio

The staff/student ratio at our campus is great compared with an average 1:45 in many foreign schools.

characteristics

verbacknowledge, appreciate, understand, grant, concede.

recognize

characteristics

verb- to tell, report, or describe in some detail an occurrence or _cir-cumstance

relate

example


